





Our Pricing Explained Secondary Schools



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Zumos is a social enterprise and our aim is to make our service free to schools by working with you to secure outside funding.

You can however start your project immediately for a payment of £995 (commitment fee) for which you will receive full access to Zumos with all features and benefits and full support.

Your school will never pay more than this commitment fee per annum.

By starting on this level, a school is obliged to:

- Make a funding application, usually to the National Lottery for the full amount (we cannot do this for you, but we can support you in submitting a good application, 1 hour approx).
- Accept certain pre-approved sponsors if we find you one i.e. banks or supermarkets.
- Supply us with wording on your school's letterhead so we can apply for public health funding on your behalf (we supply the wording).
- If agreed, approach your school suppliers by email for sponsorship (all information and docs supplied by us).
- If agreed, request donations from parents and alumni.

If you are successful in any of these funding sources anything you have paid will be refunded.

To reiterate, if no outside funding is achieved in your year of use, your school will never pay more than the £995 already paid. You will not be billed for the full balance and the cycle will start again in year two should you choose to continue by paying the commitment fee again.

Should any school not wish to accept sponsorship or outside funding then the standard cost of running the Zumos Wellbeing Project will apply which in a secondary school is £8300 per annum.
